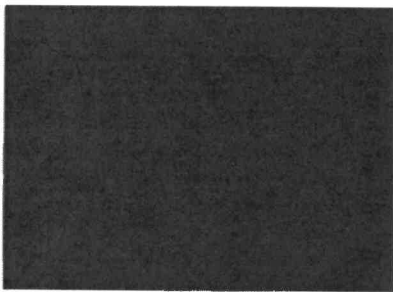

I represent Jeremy Henrichs. Thank you for confirming via voice message on August 16, 2021 that the August 11, 2021 e-mail from you to Dr. Henrichs did, in fact, originate from you in your official capacity as a Medical Investigator for the IDFPR. I had suspicions regarding the legitimacy of an email notice requesting a response from a professional licensee on the subject matter of the licensee's unrelated performance of his elected office as a school board member. Thus, I wanted to assure that no one was posing as an authorized investigator to coerce or intimidate a public official in the performance of his public duties.

Your Investigative Request did not include the referenced "Complaint" nor did the Request set a deadline for the requested response. Please advise if the Complaint is Department initiated or initiated by an outside complainant. I also ask for a copy of the originating complaint to enable a response, redacting any information that may be appropriate at this stage of your preliminary inquiry. If the Complaint does not identify the statutory or administrative basis for a Complaint, then please provide the potential violation subject to investigation. Finally, please provide a reasonable deadline for the requested response. The foregoing information is needed to enable an informed response.
