To Whom It May Concern:

[REDACTED] is a 46 y/o female who presented to my clinic, requesting allergy testing to components of the COVID-19 vaccine. For her evaluation, we did both pin prick and intradermal testing to Polysorbate and Polyethylene Glycol, along with appropriate positive and negative controls. She developed a positive reaction to intradermal testing to Polysorbate, indicating the potential for a significant allergic reaction to future COVID vaccination. I respectfully recommend that the patient be granted a medical waiver for the COVID-19 vaccine.
