Mr. Cipollone:

A former Mark Meadows aide, Cassidy Hutchinson, recently publicly testified in front of the January 6 Committee. Much of her testimony has since been disputed.

Part of her testimony recounted a conversation she allegedly had with you at the White House on the morning of January 6. Ms. Hutchinson did not provide evidence that you were at the White House during the time in question.

As you know, Speaker Pelosi made the unprecedented decision to block two of Republican Leader Kevin McCarthy's appointees to the January 6 Committee, so the Committee lacks minority representation. As a result, Republicans are conducting our own investigation into the security failure at the Capitol.

Please provide my office with written responses to the following questions by July 9, 2022:

- Approximately, at what time did you enter the White House campus on January 6, 2021?
- Did enter the White House campus before or after President Trump arrived at the Ellipse?
- Did you have any conversations with Cassidy Hutchinson on the morning of January 6, 2021?
  - Did you have the conversation with Ms. Hutchinson that she describes in the attached testimony at any time?
