- D. Detective Luker and your affiant examined a batch of (18) separate voter registration applications. When the applications were printed out and placed side by side the handwriting on the (18) forms appear to be done by the same writer and numerous signatures have similar characteristics. Your affiant noted that multiple forms were missing key information, had duplicate last names at different addresses and had inaccurate information.
- E. After consulting with Muskegon PD Detectives and MDOS Analyst Corey Ames your affiant would describe the results as finding that a quantity of the voter applications forms are clearly fraudulent, a quantity of the voter application forms are highly suspicious having either erroneous or are missing key pieces of information and merit further follow up and a quantity of the voter registration forms appear to be legitimate based on cross checks and database reviews.



I was contacted by D/F/Lt. Mike Anderson and requested to assist with this election fraud investigation on the evening of 10/28/20. I was requested to brief with the investigative team in Livonia at 9:00AM on 10/29/20. After the briefing was concluded I went near the site of the search warrant and waited until approximately 3:00PM, when uniform trooper Dustin Kieffer from the MSP Metro North Post and I made contact with inhabitants of the space rented by and executed the search warrant on the premises. told me she and work for and they rent the suites
across the hall and the room we were standing in which was the training room. I clarified, asking if she was
talking about the rooms directly across the hall. She confirmed this to be true. I asked all three individuals to stay in the training room while the search warrant was being conducted. All of them complied without incident.

At this point I knew the search warrant did not cover the suites across the hall where they had emerged from but stated did legally rent those suites. I could see computers and paperwork through the open door and I believed the suites across the hall held important evidence for this investigation. I contacted D/F/Lt. Mike Anderson and relayed this information and he amended the search warrant to include the other suites.



this time and recorded three segments of conversation. These three files were added to property in this case. For the full contents of the files, review the files.

spoke with via video chat. He identified himself as I observed a middle-aged black male with a medium build on phone/video chat screen. I asked him what was. He stated is an operations firm that helps out around campaigns. We are an operations team and we go out in the field and we knock on doors during campaigns. We send people into the community and they knock on doors uh to engage educate and mobilize the community around different elections." I went on to ask if he was currently in Michigan and he stated he is not, he is in lowa. As asked to see a copy of the search warrant and I told her I would give her a copy when I get her name and her role in the company. As soon as I obtained her name I provided her a copy of the initial search warrant. This occurred soon after the first conversation with ended. I also heard telling that she needed to make sure she declared the personal tems he left behind before leaving the state. It should be noted it was later found that he was referring to multiple firearms and ammunition within one of their suites as noted in D/F/Lt. Anderson's report.
While waiting for the updated search warrant a few more employees from arrived on scene and were asked to come into the training room to avoid going into the secured area we had cleared. All of them were cooperative with this request. Also during that time 2 nd District SIS MSP employees D/Lt. Richard Sanchez, along with Detective Troopers Chang, Pirvu, and Terrill arrived to assist. They interviewed those present who were willing to be interviewed. See their reports for content of the interviews. D/Tpr. Pirvu interviewed employee completed a written statement which was placed in external documents. D/Tpr. Chang interviewed employee and documented the interview in her original report. D/Tpr. Terrill interviewed and documented the interview in a supplemental report to D/Tpr. Chang's original report. I asked fishe was willing to be interviewed and she declined stating she did not want to talk further without consulting with a lawyer.
Also, while waiting for the amended search warrant approached me and stated the attorney for wanted to speak with me. His name was Brian Lennon and he was with the law firm Warner Norcross & Judd. Brian gave me his cell phone number which was 616-901-7693. Brian stated his firm was being retained by for this investigation and he had just spoken with someone from in Atlanta about being retained as putside counsel for this case. Brian stated would be fully cooperative and wanted to give investigators whatever they needed to do their investigation. Brian asked me if we would be seizing hardware from the rented space as part of this investigation. I told him I presumed we would but did not know how much we would take at that time. I obtained his cell phone number and then called him after clearing the scene that evening, relling him a synopsis of what we had seized.
