BLUF: a 7.4 earthquake off the coast of British Columbia has cause a tsunami. Don't expect issues for CA or Oregon. Tsunami warning in Hawaii now, evacuation sirens are going off. Greatest impact expected for Maui. We're abt 90mins from the waves hitting the coast. Open source media is reporting orderly evacuations now in Waikiki etc. Worst case scenario at the time appears top be 5-7+ feet waves.

John is going to call POTUS now.
