CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

16 The District Attorney of Madera County, California, hereby accuses the above-named
17 defendant of the following criminal offenses:

19 Count 1

20 On or about January 30, 2024, in the County of Madera, State of California, the crime of
21 Forcible Rape in violation of PC 261(a)(2), a Felony, was committed in that TREMAINE D
22 CARROLL did unlawfully have and accomplish an act of sexual intercourse with a person, to wit,
23 Jane Doe, not against said person's will, by means of force, violence, duress, menace and fear of
24 immediate and unlawful bodily injury on said person and another.

25 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require the court to order you to submit to a blood
26 test for evidence of antibodies to the probable causative agent of Acquired Immune Deficiency
27 Syndrome (AIDS). Penal Code Section 1202.1.

1 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code
2 section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

3 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section
4 1192.7(c) and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 667.5(c)

6 ENHANCEMENT 1

7 It is further alleged as to Count 1 pursuant to Penal Code sections 667(b) through (i) that the
8 defendant, TREMAINE D CARROLL, has suffered the following prior convictions of a serious or
9 violent felony or juvenile adjudication:
