Minnesota & Virginia Are Clearly In Play & Prime Opportunities to Flip for Donald Trump

Recent Minnesota and Virginia polls conducted on behalf of Trump 47 and the RNC showcase ballot scenarios where Donald Trump is ahead or in highly contested races against Joe Biden who is underperforming and very vulnerable.

Among 600 likely voters in Minnesota, Donald Trump is tied at 40% in a 6-way ballot including Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. In ballots without Robert F. Kennedy Jr., Trump takes the lead.

Among 800 likely voters in Virginia, Donald Trump is right on the heels of Joe Biden in very competitive ballot scenarios with and without Robert F. Kennedy Jr.

In both states, Donald Trump finds himself in positions to flip key electoral votes in his favor.

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Methodology & Demographics:

The Virginia and Minnesota surveys were conducted among 800 and 600 likely general election voters, respectively, between April 29 and May 1, 2024. The survey included a mix of landline phone, mobile phone, and text-to-web interviews. Interview selection was at random within predetermined election units. Geographic and demographic segments reflect a presidential general election turnout model. The accuracy of the sample of 800 likely general election voters in Virginia is within +/- 3.4% at a 95% confidence interval. The accuracy of the sample of 600 likely general election voters in Minnesota is within +/- 4.0% at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this presentation have been rounded and may not equal 100%.
