What are our top priorities:

- 1. City divestment resolution
 - details to be worked out, cant be directly simple as BDS as scope would be different for city. fyi, there is legislation trying to make BDS illegal
 - refer to NE legislation, municipal divestment case studies in anti zionist resolution
 - city run grocery store to follow BDS
 - city agencies also follow BDS, like dropping HP

2. NYPD

- End NYPD training with IOF
- End serving in other cities like Singapore
- End repression of demonstrators against genocide
- 3. Ban illegal land sales
- 4. Arrest Netanyahu or any Israeli leadership
 - how much will NYPD cooperate
 - NYPD can use iCard (internal to NYPD)

How will we implement?

- 1. Track/ stay active on appointments
 - Who he appoints to positions like NYPD commissioner will be key to implementing
 - Pressure him to staff with people whose values are aligned
- 2. Work with smaller elected officials as well/ bottom-up approach
 - Folks like Brisport, Calaban, Aviles
 - Zohran maybe out of reach for awwg
- 3. Communication Management

- Asks can be taken out of context, how/ what we communicate would be important
- 4. Leverage Zohran campaign/ canvassing infrastructure
 - Electoralism in DSA is anti imperialism
 - Canvassers care about Palestine, many there because of Palestine
 - Reach out to canvass leads, share these demands
- 5. Plan and push forward through conflict with political priorities
 - Make it clear to electeds that if they want our support, our priorities matter
 - Make the terms clear going in, public statement on 1st day
 - However focus on policies and actions, not statements in response to bad faith questions from press
- 6. Provide plan for him to implement
 - Make it easy for him
 - Mobilize to show and shift public support
