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Details:

This Electronic Communication seeks approval to close the captioned full Sensitive Investigative Matter (SIM) investigation as a C-5 closing following a declination from the Department of Justice. The Domestic Investigations and Operations Guide (DIOG) Section 7.12.1 provides the standards for closing a full investigation, which are discussed herein. In accordance with DIOG Section 7.12.2(C), because this was a SIM opened by a Field Office and involved a presidential candidate, the same level of approval required to open the investigation is also required to close the investigation. The approval roles on this closing EC match those of the opening EC and, as such, Washington Field Office is seeking approval up to and including the Director of the FBI to close this investigation.

Closing Standard**• Summary of the Results of the Investigation**


On April 13, 2022, following the signed approval of both FBI Director Christopher Wray and Attorney General Merrick Garland, the captioned FBI investigation was opened based on specific and articulable facts and circumstances that individuals affiliated with Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. (the "Trump Campaign") engaged in activity that violated federal law, particularly 18 U.S.C. § 1512(c)(2) and (k) (attempt or conspiracy to corruptly obstruct, influence, and impede the certification of the Electoral College vote), 18 U.S.C. § 371 (conspiracy), and related statutes. See Serial 1. In or around May 2022, additional predication was documented and this investigation was merged with an investigation then being conducted by the Department of Justice, Office of Inspector General. See Serial 65.

On November 18, 2022, Attorney General Merrick Garland issued Order No. 5559-2022, appointing John L. Smith as Special Counsel for this investigation. See Serial 440.

During the course of the investigation, various investigative techniques were used. For example, [REDACTED]

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The investigation revealed that when Donald J. Trump (Trump) lost the 2020 presidential election, he resorted to crimes to try to stay in office. With various co-conspirators, Trump launched a series of plans to overturn the legitimate election results in seven states that he had lost – Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Nevada, New Mexico, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin (the “targeted states”). His efforts included lying to state officials in order to induce them to ignore true vote counts; manufacturing fraudulent electoral votes in the targeted states; attempting to enlist Vice President Pence to obstruct Congress’s certification of the election by using fraudulent electoral votes; and on January 6, 2021, directed a crowd of supporters to the United States Capitol to obstruct the congressional certification. Trump and his co-conspirators used knowingly false claims of election fraud in furtherance of three conspiracies: 1) a conspiracy to interfere with the federal government function by which the nation collects and counts election results, which is set forth in the Constitution and the Electoral Count Act (ECA); 2) a conspiracy to obstruct the official proceeding in which Congress certifies the legitimate results of the presidential election; and 3) a conspiracy against the rights of millions of Americans to vote and have their votes counted.

As a result of the investigation, on or about August 1, 2023, a Grand Jury sitting in the District of Columbia returned a True Bill on an Indictment charging Trump with violations of 18 U.S.C. § 371 (conspiracy to defraud the United States), 18 U.S.C. § 1512(k) (conspiracy to obstruct an official proceeding), 18 U.S.C. § 1512(c)(2) and 2

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(obstruction of an official proceeding & attempt to obstruct an official proceeding), and 18 U.S.C. § 241 (conspiracy against rights). See *United States v. Trump*, 23-CR-257-TSC, ECF No. 1 (Aug. 1, 2023); Serial 1021. Following an appeal to the Supreme Court regarding presidential immunity, on August 27, 2024, a grand jury returned a True Bill on a Superseding Indictment, charging Trump with the same four felony counts. See *id.*, ECF No. 226 (Aug. 27, 2024); Serial 1196 (collectively, the "Indictments").

The case did not proceed to trial, as further detailed below.

- **Resources Expended**

Sufficient personnel and financial resources were expended on the investigation. Varying numbers of agents, analysts, and other support staff were assigned to this investigation, as necessary.

- **Logical and Reasonable Investigation Completion**

A logical and reasonable investigation was completed, resulting in the Indictments.

- **Completion of Investigative Techniques**

All investigative methods and techniques that were initiated have been completed and/or discontinued.

- **Leads**

All leads set have been completed or discontinued.

- **Disposition of Evidence**

This investigation is subject to a litigation hold and is on the freeze list; as a result, no evidence can be returned or destroyed and must be retained. As required by the Field Evidence Management Policy Guide Sections 4.15 & 4.18, ASAC approval to retain all evidence notwithstanding closure was obtained (Serial 1206) and is attached hereto as a 1A for ease of review. The Retention EC specifies that the evidence

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will be retained until at least February 1, 2030, but in no case prior to the lift of the freeze and litigation hold and that the Special Counsel's Office concurred with the retention of evidence.

• **Summary of the Reason for Closing**

Trump argued that he was immune from prosecution based on constitutional grounds, including presidential immunity. See *United States v. Trump*, 23-CR-257-TSC, Nos. 113 (Trump motion to dismiss), 171 & 172 (District Court denial), 186 (Trump appeal to D.C. Circuit); Serial 1206; *United States v. Trump*, 91 F.4th 1173 (D.C. Cir. 2024) (*per curiam*) (affirming District Court); *Trump v. United States*, Case No. 23A745, ECF No. 1 (Feb. 12, 2024) (Trump appeal to Supreme Court). On July 1, 2024, the Supreme Court held that Trump was immune from prosecution for certain abuses of official power alleged in the Original Indictment, vacated the Judgment of the District Court, and remanded for further proceedings. See *Trump v. United States*, 603 U.S. 593, 642 (2024).

On August 27, 2024, a grand jury returned a True Bill on the Superseding Indictment, charging Trump with four felony counts. See Serial 1196. The United States then moved the District Court to determine whether certain conduct alleged in the Superseding Indictment was immune from prosecution. See *US v. Trump*, 23-CR-257-TSC, ECF No. 252. Trump never filed a response.

As a result of the November 5, 2024 election, Trump is now president-elect and will be inaugurated as president on January 20, 2025. As a result of the Department of Justice, Office of Legal Counsel's opinion that a sitting president cannot be federally indicted and prosecuted, the United States moved to dismiss the Indictments without prejudice before Trump's inauguration. See *United States v. Trump*, 23-CR-257-TSC, ECF No. 281. On November 25, 2024, the District Court granted the Government's unopposed motion and dismissed the Indictments without prejudice. See *id.*, ECF Nos. 282 & 283.

Department of Justice Concurrence

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On January 8, 2025, the Deputy Special Counsel provided the attached email declination of prosecution stating in part: "The SCO has submitted a final confidential report to the Attorney General, has concluded its work, and is winding down the office. Under the circumstances, the SCO must decline further prosecution of the FBI's Arctic Frost Investigation, and we do not object to FBI closing the case file. As stated in public filings, the SCO dismissed the case against Donald Trump based on his impending inauguration as president, consistent with the Department's longstanding policy prohibiting the indictment and prosecution of a sitting president; the dismissal was not based on the merits of the prosecution, which the SCO stands behind." The email further states, "Because the SCO reached no final conclusions [regarding the prosecution of co-conspirators], our declination of further prosecution should not be read to exonerate any particular person."

Summary

The undersigned respectfully requests approval, up to and including the Director of the FBI, to close the captioned full SIM investigation while retaining the evidence in the FBI's custody and control. See DIOG Section 7.12.2(C). The Deputy Director's approval of this communication in Sentinel indicates that the Director has approved the closure of the investigation.

Synopsis: (U// [REDACTED]) This communication documents the opening of a new 56D full investigative matter predicated on information subjects corruptly conspired to obstruct the United States Congress' certification of the 2020 Presidential election results by submitting fraudulent certificates of electors' votes to the United States Government. The processes by which these certificates were created, signed, and sent to the United States Government and the purpose for which they were intended to be used violated multiple criminal statutes over which the United States Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation have jurisdiction.

Administrative Notes: (U// [REDACTED]) Per FBI policy, opening 56D cases are approved at the SAC level. Due to a potential conflict of interest, ADIC WFO will be the approving official on this EC in lieu of SAC, Criminal and Cyber Division.

Details:

Captioned investigation is being opened based on specific and articulable facts and circumstances detailed herein that individuals affiliated with Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. (Trump Campaign) engaged in activity that violates federal law, particularly 18 U.S.C. § 1512(c)(2) and (k) (attempt or conspiracy to corruptly obstruct, influence, and impede the certification of the Electoral College vote), 18 U.S.C. § 371 (conspiracy), and related statutes. As detailed below, the FBI has obtained evidence suggesting individuals representing the Trump Campaign conspired to corruptly obstruct the United States Congress' certification of the 2020 Presidential election results by submitting allegedly fraudulent elector certificates and attempting to convince Vice President Michael Pence (Pence) to rely on the fraudulent certificates of electors on January 6, 2021, during a Joint Session of Congress.

RELEVANT FACTS, CIRCUMSTANCES, AND ALLEGATIONS:

The Electoral College

The Electoral College refers to the process by which the United States elects the President and Vice President through

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the selection of electors by the individual States and the District of Columbia.

The United States Constitution vests in the State legislatures the manner of appointment of electors. However, federal Constitutional and statutory requirements also apply. Specifically, Title 3, Chapter 1 of the United States Code sets forth certain requirements regarding Presidential elections and electors. Under 3 U.S.C. § 1, the electors for President and Vice President "shall be appointed, in each State, on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November" during Presidential election years. After the electors are appointed, each state Governor is obliged "to deliver to the electors of such State, on or before the day on which they are required by 3 U.S.C. § 7 to meet, six duplicate-originals of the same certificate under the seal of the State." 3 U.S.C. § 6. The electors are required to "meet and give their votes on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December next following their appointment at such place in each State as the legislature of such State shall direct." 3 U.S.C. § 7.

In December 2020, as in prior years, the electors had certain responsibilities with respect to the aforementioned "six duplicate-originals" respective state Governors provided to state electors. First, electors had to "make and sign" each of the six certificates." 3 U.S.C. § 9. Electors were also required to "annex to each of the certificates one of the lists of the electors which shall have been furnished to them by direction of the executive of the State" (i.e., the Governors). 3 U.S.C. § 9. Second, the electors were required to specially seal and certify the certificates. 3 U.S.C. § 10. Third, the electors were to "dispose" of the six certificates as follows: by sending one certificate by registered mail "to the President of the Senate at the seat of government;" by delivering two certificates to the "secretary of state of the State;" by sending two certificates by registered mail to the "Archivist of the United States at the seat of government;" and by delivering the final certificate "to the judge of the district in which the electors shall have assembled." 3 U.S.C. § 11.

Fraudulent Certificates

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On December 14, 2020, electors gathered in all fifty states and the District of Columbia to cast and certify their votes for the President and Vice President "in the manner directed by the Constitution" and consistent with their statutory duties. 3 U.S.C. § 8.

In addition to the legitimate certificates, allegedly fraudulent certificates were sent to the Archivist of the United States, purporting to represent the elector votes from five states. The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA), on behalf of the Archivist of the United States, coordinates certain Electoral College functions between the States and Congress. Acting as an intermediary, NARA reviews "Certificates of Ascertainment and Vote" before Congress accepts them as evidence of official State action in preparation for the counting of electoral votes in Congress. Allegedly fraudulent certificates were received from Arizona (11 electors), Georgia (16 electors), Michigan (16 electors), Nevada (6 electors), and Wisconsin (10 electors) and are publicly available.

A review of the allegedly fraudulent certificates indicated they were in substantially similar form (e.g., similar content, wording, and document length), suggesting they were created either by one actor or through coordination among allegedly fraudulent elector groups. Each of the documents was signed by certain individuals representing to "be the duly elected and qualified Electors for President and Vice President" from each of the five effected states, and purported to cast all of their electoral votes for then President Donald J. Trump (Trump) and Pence.

Individuals in two other states - New Mexico (5 electors) and Pennsylvania (20 electors) - sent similar certificates, but with an additional caveat that appears to be relevant in the proposed investigation. The certificates for those states were "certified on the understanding that if, as a result of a final non-appealable Court Order or other proceeding prescribed by law, we are ultimately recognized as being the duly elected and qualified Electors."

The submission of allegedly fraudulent certificates appears to

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have been solicited by the Trump Campaign. For example, on December 14, 2020, the Pennsylvania GOP issued a news release on pagop.org titled "Republican Electors Cast Procedural Vote, Seek to Preserve Trump Campaign Legal Challenge." According to the release, "At the request of the Trump campaign, the Republican presidential electors met today in Harrisburg to cast a conditional vote for Donald Trump and Mike Pence for President and Vice President respectively."

Additionally, an individual purported to be [REDACTED] co-chair of Michigan Republican Party and one of the allegedly fraudulent electors from Michigan, was audio-recorded as claiming that "We fought to seat the electors. The Trump Campaign asked us to do that. [Inaudible] under a lot of scrutiny for that today." [REDACTED], *Trump campaign electors plot in 7 states*, CNN.com, Jan. 20, 2022 (containing content of the audio recording).

Public Statements by the Trump Campaign

On December 14, 2020, [REDACTED] appeared on a podcast hosted by [REDACTED] entitled "[REDACTED] war room." The two discussed [REDACTED] and the Trump Campaign sending Trump electors to the state capitols. See War Room, Episode 582. In part, [REDACTED] asked, "Why is the Trump Campaign sending its own slate of electors to these state capitols?" [REDACTED] responded in part that they were doing so "out of an excess of caution." *Id.*

Subsequently, on January 2, 2021, [REDACTED] appeared on [REDACTED] podcast. During the podcast episode, [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as "the Constitutional lawyer for the President," [REDACTED] as "the head lawyer," and [REDACTED] as "the deputy over there" and "from the Campaign," suggesting each of these men was working in some capacity on behalf of the Trump Campaign. See War Room, Episode 625.

During the same January 2, 2021 podcast, [REDACTED] further stated, "The Vice President has an extensive amount of power. And when it does come on the 6th, we already know that there is [sic]

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electors from both the Biden side and the Trump side that have been sent to Congress. That was done on December 14th. The Vice President's got a lot of power and that's very important to recognize." further stated, "The Vice President has a ton of power in terms of opening and counting the Electoral College votes at the Joint Session on the 6th. That power is enumerated in the Twelfth Amendment of the Constitution." After claiming there was extensive election fraud in the 2020 election, stated, "I think if the Vice President, as presiding over the Joint Session would at least agree that because those ongoing contests have not been resolved we can't count those electors, that, that, that means that nobody has a majority of the electors. Um, and either they delay things, so those Constitutional challenges are resolved, uh, or they say, 'Oh, we don't have electors from those states that nobody has a majority, this is going to the House.'"

According to testimony given to the Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol (Select Committee) by at the time of the attack, a meeting occurred in the Oval Office on January 4, 2021 between , Pence, Trump, , and . See Transcript of Interview of (Feb. 1, 2022), Select Committee, at 82, disclosed in 22-CV-00099-DOC-DFM, ECF No. 160-8. It was impression during the meeting was "trying to persuade" Pence to take actions with respect to the electors. See *id.* at 89-96. appeared to present two options as legally viable, including that Pence could reject the electors from the states that sent in allegedly fraudulent certificates. See *id.* at 91. But suggested "he thought that the more prudent course was a procedural send it back to the States, rather than reject electors." *Id.*

further testified that in a meeting on January 5, 2021, changed his recommendation and started the meeting by saying, "I'm here asking you to reject the electors." *Id.* at 92. During the meeting, "acknowledged that there had been discussions of other possibilities the day before, but that's what he was here to talk about today." *Id.* During the meeting,

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conceded that no Supreme Court Justice would accept his argument. *Id.* at 110. refused this request. *See id.* at 111.

Additionally, in a January 21, 2022 news interview, said, "Yes, I was part of the process to make sure there were alternate electors for when as we hoped the challenges to the seated electors would be heard and be successful." further stated, "Everything that was done was done legally by the Trump legal team by, according to, to the rules and under the leadership of " *See Sonnet Swire, Former Trump campaign advisor acknowledges part of 2020 'alternate electors' plot*, CNN.com, Jan. 22, 2022 (containing content of audio recording).

January 6, 2021

On January 6, 2021, a Joint Session of Congress convened at the United States Capitol to certify the vote count of the Electoral College for the 2020 Presidential election as required by statute. 3 U.S.C. § 15. Prior to convening the Joint Session, Pence sent a letter to Congress appearing to acknowledge the Trump Campaign's efforts regarding the electors. The letter, posted to Twitter by his office at approximately 1:02 p.m. stated in part:

Some believe that as Vice President, I should be able to accept or reject electoral votes unilaterally. Others believe that electoral votes should never be challenged in a Joint Session of Congress. After a careful study of our Constitution, our laws, and our history, I believe neither view is correct. . . . It is my considered judgment that my oath to support and defend the Constitution constrains me from claiming unilateral authority to determine which electoral votes should be counted and which should not.

At approximately 2 p.m., protestors breached the Capitol in an effort to stop the certification of the votes.

Hours later when rioters had been cleared from the Capitol, the Joint Session resumed. In records disclosed by the Select Committee, seemed to continue to pressure Pence, stating in an email to at approximately 12:44 a.m. on January 7, "I implore you to consider one more relatively minor violation and

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adjourn for 10 days to allow the legislatures to finish their investigations, as well as to allow a full forensic audit of the massive amount of illegal activity that has occurred here." [REDACTED] [REDACTED], at ECF No. 160-16. [One of the objectives of the proposed investigation is to confirm the source and authenticity of these documents.]

At approximately 3:55 a.m. on January 7, 2021, Pence called a majority of the Electoral College votes for Biden.

FEDERAL VIOLATIONS:

By conspiring, attempting to submit, and/or submitting allegedly fraudulent elector certificates, subjects, both known and unknown, may have violated one or more of the following federal statutes of which the FBI has enforcement responsibility:

- Attempt or conspiracy to corruptly obstruct, influence, and impede the certification of the Electoral College vote (18 U.S.C. § 1512(c)(2) and (k))
- Obstruction of certain proceedings (18 U.S.C. § 1505)
- Falsification of records (18 U.S.C. § 1519)
- Conspiracy to defraud the United States (18 U.S.C. § 371)
- Aiding and abetting (18 U.S.C. § 2)
- Mail Fraud (18 U.S.C. § 1341)
- Seditious Conspiracy (18 U.S.C. § 2384)

STATEMENT OF PREDICATION AND APPROVALS REQUIRED TO OPEN THIS SIM FULL INVESTIGATION:

In accordance with DIOG Sections 7.1-7.2, based on the facts and information described above, there is a specific and articulable factual basis indicating activity constituting a federal crime or crimes has occurred.

Per DIOG section 10.1.2, this investigation is considered a sensitive investigative matter (SIM) due to the potential involvement or activities of a domestic public official, domestic political organization, or individual prominent in such an organization.

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In addition to the standard requirements for opening a SIM set forth in the DIOG, opening of this Full Investigation is also governed by 1) the Memorandum from the Attorney General dated February 5, 2020, entitled "Additional Requirements for the Opening of Certain Sensitive Investigations" ("AG Memo"), and 2) FBI Policy Notice 1096N, entitled "Updated Requirements for Certain Investigative Matters Related to Presidential and Congressional Candidates and Campaigns" (FBI Policy 1096N). The AG Memo and FBI Policy 1096N apply to investigations and assessments potentially targeted on, inter alia, declared Presidential and Vice Presidential candidates, a Presidential campaign, or a senior Presidential campaign staff member or advisor, and they apply to this Full Investigation because the subject pool potentially includes individuals who fall in one or more of those three categories, as further discussed below.

Per FBI Policy 1096N, "certain investigative matters should be brought to the attention of Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) management and Department of Justice (DOJ) officials." While PN 1096N does not define "declared candidate for President", "Presidential campaign", or "Senior Presidential campaign staff members or advisors", the policy states: "If unsure whether an investigative matter meets these criteria, FBI personnel should err on the side of inclusion and adhere to the requirements contained herein." In addition, the underlying Attorney General memorandum, entitled "Additional Requirements for the Opening of Certain Sensitive Investigations," states, "The scope of this memorandum should be broadly construed to ensure that Department leadership is made aware of the opening of matters that could potentially be disruptive to our democratic processes if publicly disclosed prior to an election. You should err on the side of consulting or seeking approval if there could be any question as to whether such actions are required under this policy."

Per FBI Policy 1096N, 5.1.3. "Prior to opening or initiating a predicated investigation, FBI personnel must meet all of the following requirements:"

- Chief Division Counsel (CDC) review

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- SAC Approval
- Director Approval Written notification to, and consultation with, the AAG(s) and the U.S. Attorney(s) with jurisdiction over the matter
- Written approval of the AG, through the Deputy Attorney General (DAG)

WFO and HQ have discussed the matter with the AAG of the Criminal Division. To further ensure compliance with FBI Policy 1096N, a lead is set for HQ to expeditiously provide written notice to the AAG of the Criminal Division and the U.S. Attorney's Office with jurisdiction, as well as obtain written approval of the AG, through the DAG, upon approval of this EC.

The Deputy Director's approval of this communication in Sentinel indicates that the Director has approved the investigation and that the applicable process pursuant to the Attorney General's memorandum, "Additional Requirements for the Opening of Certain Sensitive Investigations" (February 5, 2020), has been followed, and that the Attorney General memorandum authorizing the initiation of this full investigation will be memorialized to the case file. The opening of the full investigation will not be effected until written approval from the Attorney General is received by the FBI.

VENUE:

Although relevant activity occurred in multiple states and jurisdictions, the allegedly fraudulent certificates were mailed to Washington, DC and were received by NARA in Washington, DC. Additionally, Washington, DC is the location where the effects of the criminal activity were felt. As a result, as per consultation with the USAODC, venue likely lies in the District of Columbia. It is also noted Washington Field Office (WFO) is uniquely qualified by experience and location to investigate this matter.

UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICE CONCURRENCE:

United States Attorney Matthew Graves, USAODC, concurs with the initiation of this investigation. On February 17, 2022, Assistant United States Attorney advised WFO he had

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previously opened a related Grand Jury investigation with other federal law enforcement agencies on January 31, 2022, under USAO Case Number 2022R00150.

OTHER INVESTIGATIVE ENTITIES:

Prior to the FBI's involvement in the case, agents from the United States Postal Inspection Service and the Investigative Unit of the Office of the Inspector General for the National Archives had both opened investigations related to this matter and were coordinating with the USAODC. WFO will coordinate with USAODC to ensure the FBI has primary responsibility for the investigation.

IDENTIFICATION OF SUBJECTS:

Donald J. Trump for President, Inc.

As detailed herein, representatives of the Trump Campaign, including and others, were involved in an alleged scheme to convince vice President Pence to use allegedly fraudulent elector certificates to overturn the 2020 election.

As noted in a press release, the Republican Party in Pennsylvania indicated that their "conditional vote" for Trump was submitted "At the request of the Trump campaign." Additionally, one of the allegedly fraudulent electors from Michigan was audio-recorded as claiming that "We fought to seat the electors. The Trump Campaign asked us to do that."

In a public filing on January 22, 2022, filed a Declaration stating that he was engaged to represent Trump "in his capacity as a candidate for President of the United States, and Donald J. Trump for President, Inc." ECF No. 132-1, at 11. According to filing, engagement letter indicated was retained to represent Trump and the Trump Campaign "in federal litigation matters in relation to the 2020 presidential general election, including election matters related to the Electoral College." See *id.*

drafted a memorandum entitled "January 6 scenario" (the Memo), proposing Pence refuse to count certified

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electoral votes from states contested by the Trump campaign. See [REDACTED], Order Re Privilege of Documents Dated January 4-7, 2021, ECF No. 260 at 6. [REDACTED] appears to have known about the apparent fraudulent elector certificates when he prepared the Memo because it begins with the line "7 states have transmitted dual slates of electors to the President of the Senate." The memo goes on to detail scenarios in which Pence could use the purportedly "dual" slates of electors in order to achieve the goal of keeping President Trump in office for a second term. Both scenarios required Pence to declare that "because of the ongoing disputes in the 7 States, there are no electors that can be deemed validly appointed in those States," and throw out the legitimate elector certificates from those seven states. [REDACTED] alternatively proposed that Pence should adjourn the Joint Session for ten days in order for the state legislatures to finish their investigations, in direct violation of federal law.

[REDACTED] purported to be Trump's attorney and an attorney for the Trump Campaign. On November 19, 2020, [REDACTED] and other legal representatives from the Trump Campaign, held a press conference regarding alleged voter fraud in the 2020 election. On December 14, 2020, [REDACTED] appeared on [REDACTED] podcast and discussed the Trump Campaign sending Trump electors to the state Capitols. In part [REDACTED] asked, "Why is the Trump campaign sending its own slate of electors to these state Capitols?" [REDACTED] responded in part that they were doing so "out of an excess of caution."

[REDACTED] Attorney [REDACTED] also represented the Trump Campaign. In a January 21, 2022 news interview detailed above, [REDACTED] publicly admitted, "Yes, I was part of the process to make sure there were alternate electors for when as we hoped the challenges to the seated electors would be heard and be successful. . . . Everything that was done was done legally by the Trump legal team by, according to, to the rules and under the leadership of [REDACTED]

Approximately 60 individuals in Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Nevada, and Wisconsin signed allegedly fraudulent certificates in addition to other individuals as yet unknown who may have coordinated efforts among the individuals in different states. A list of the known allegedly fraudulent electors is attached to this communication.

INVESTIGATIVE PLAN:

The investigative plan will likely include the following steps:

- Full identification of known subjects, including biographical particulars and locations.
- Review pertinent open source materials including videos regarding the conspiracy to obstruct and the other crimes noted above.
- In coordination with the USAODC, issuance of [REDACTED] as appropriate.
- As such records are identified, issuance of preservation letters for relevant records.
- In coordination with USAODC, as [REDACTED]
- Conduct witness interviews and related investigation including, but not limited to:
 - A subset of the legitimate electors in each State, in order to determine and establish potential testimony about and witnesses for processes associated with legitimate electoral certificates.
 - Coordination with The Archivist of the United States to locate and preserve original evidence such as mailed allegedly fraudulent certificates which may contain forensic evidence, such as fingerprints and impression evidence, that may link the certificates to specific subjects known and unknown.
 - Coordination with The Archivist of the United States, to determine, understand, and document the processes which occurred related to the legitimate and illegitimate

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certificates, for example, to what degree the certificates were ever viewed as legitimate or if there was any attempt to withdraw such certificates.

- Identify and interview the parliamentarian of the Senate and/or House of Representatives who may have consulted with Pence on this matter.
- Work through and with United States Postal Inspection Service to locate and preserve as evidence any documents and records associated with registered mail sent to the Archivist and President of the Senate.
- Conduct or attempt to conduct one or more sensitive interviews of potential witnesses in the matter.

APPROVAL DOCUMENTATION AND REQUIRED NOTIFICATIONS:

The proposed investigation is considered a SIM and per DIOG section 7.7.1.1. requires Chief Division Counsel review and SAC approval to open. Per DIOG, an LHM for distribution as deemed necessary is attached hereto with an informational lead for Public Corruption Unit for distributions.

Pursuant to the AG Barr Memorandum dated February 5, 2020 (Barr Memorandum), DOJ is "charged with the responsibility of protecting the integrity of our elections and democratic system of government against improper influences." As a result, certain investigations require heightened notification to ensure "particular care" is exercised by the Department and its law enforcement agencies. In accordance with the Barr Memorandum, WFO is seeking additional approval in excess of that required under DIOG 7.7.1.1. because the matter involves individuals who represented the former president and members of the former president's campaign team (See Page 2, Number 1 of the Barr Memorandum).

DOJ Public Integrity Section has also been notified and has concurred with opening. In particular, on January 28, 2022, Richard Pilger, Director, Election Crimes Branch, Public Integrity Section provided email concurrence for a full-field and Grand Jury investigation of the alleged criminal activity.

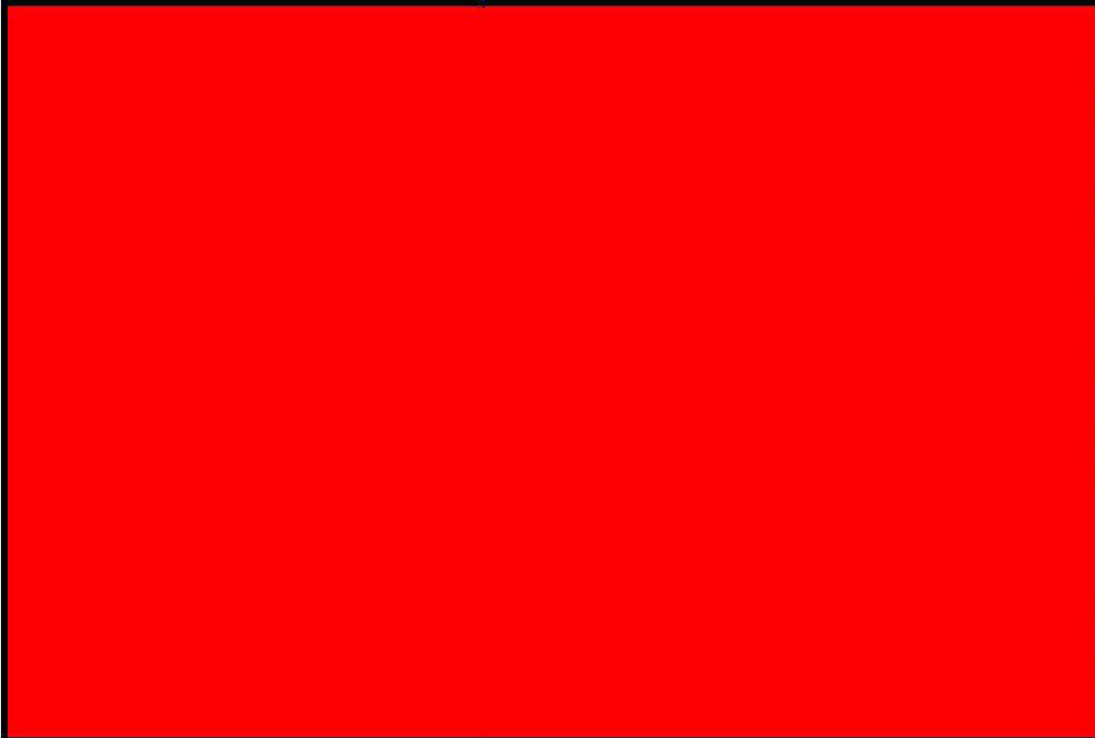

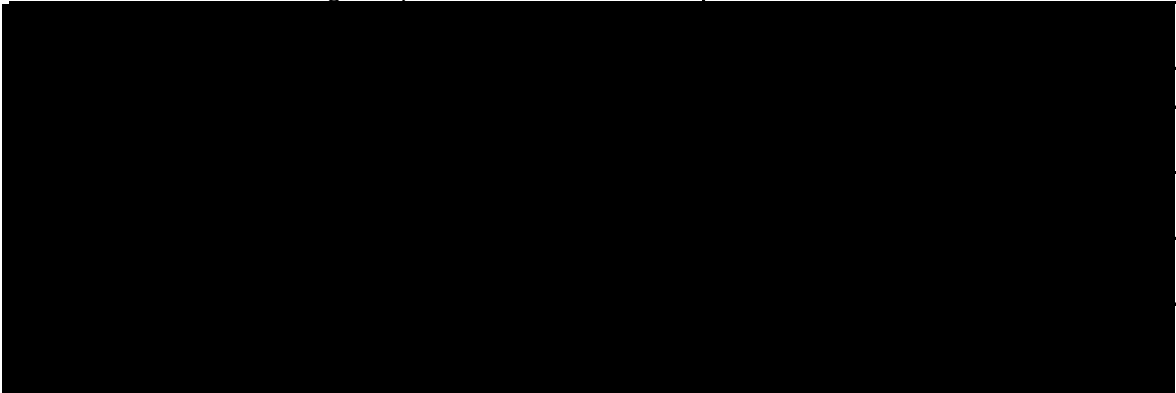

PURPOSE: To obtain your signature authorizing the Washington Field Office (WFO) to open a full sensitive investigative matter (SIM). This request is based on the recommendation of the Deputy Director, Executive Assistant Director Criminal, Cyber, Response, and Services Branch, and the Assistant Director in Charge, WFO.

AG DECISION REQUESTED BY: Your approval is requested as soon as possible. Due to the nature of the SIM at issue and pursuant to DOJ guidance, WFO may not open this full investigation without your authorization.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Following the 2020 Presidential and Vice Presidential election, in an apparent effort to obstruct Congress's certification of the Electoral College, fraudulent certificates of electors' votes were submitted to the Archivist of the United States, purporting to represent the actual elector votes from the states of Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Nevada, and Wisconsin. Open source reporting and public statements made by individuals closely associated with Donald J. Trump, Inc. (Trump Campaign) present an articulable factual basis indicating the existence of a federal crime, and thus the FBI seeks to open a full investigation. Because this investigation involves a SIM as set forth in the Department of Justice Memorandum dated February 5, 2020, entitled "Additional Requirements for the Opening of Certain Sensitive Investigations" (DOJ Memo), your authorization is required before WFO may initiate this full investigation.

DISCUSSION: WFO seeks to open this SIM full investigation based on evidence that presents specific and articulable facts that individuals, both known and unknown, engaged in a conspiracy to obstruct Congress's certification of the Electoral College on January 6, 2020, including through the submission of fraudulent certificates of electors' votes to the United States Government.

Following the 2020 Presidential and Vice Presidential election, fraudulent certificates of electors' votes were sent to the Archivist of the United States, purporting to represent the actual elector votes from five states: Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, Nevada, and Wisconsin. A review of the fraudulent certificates indicated they were in substantially similar form (e.g., similar content, wording, and document length), suggesting they were created either by one actor or through coordination among allegedly fraudulent elector groups. Each of the documents purported to cast all of their electoral votes for then-President Donald Trump and Vice President Michael Pence. Individuals in two other states, New Mexico and Pennsylvania, sent similar certificates to the Archivist, but with an additional caveat stating that the certificates for those states were "certified on the understanding that if, as a result of a final non-appealable Court Order or other proceeding prescribed by law, we are ultimately recognized as being the duly elected and qualified Electors."

On December 14, 2020, the Pennsylvania Republican Party issued a news release on pagop.org entitled "Republican Electors Cast Procedural Vote, Seek to Preserve Trump Campaign Legal Challenge." According to the release, "[A]t the request of the Trump campaign, the Republican presidential electors met today in Harrisburg to cast a conditional vote for Donald Trump and Mike Pence for President and Vice President respectively." On January 20, 2022, an individual purporting to be an elector from the state of Michigan was audio-recorded, claiming, "[W]e fought to seat the electors. The Trump Campaign asked us to do that. [Inaudible] under a lot of scrutiny for that today."

Several other individuals who were closely associated with the Trump Campaign have made public statements implicating themselves in a conspiracy to obstruct Congress's certification of the Electoral College. Appearing on a podcast on December 14, 2020, and asked why the Trump Campaign was sending its own slate of electors to various state capitals, one individual with close ties to the Trump Campaign responded that the campaign was doing so "out of an excess of caution." Another individual associated with the Trump Campaign, in a January 21, 2022 interview with CNN.com, stated, "[Y]es, I was part of the process to make sure there were alternate electors for when we hoped the challenges to the seated electors would be heard and be successful." In addition, a third individual affiliated with the Trump Campaign drafted a memorandum entitled "January 6 Scenario," detailing options for the Vice President during Congress's certification of the Electoral College. This memorandum states "7 states have transmitted dual slates of electors to the President of the Senate," and outlines scenarios in which the Vice President could use the dual slates of electors to achieve the objective of keeping President Trump in office for a second term. Both scenarios required the Vice President to determine that "because of the ongoing disputes in the 7 states, there are no electors that can be deemed validly appointed in those states" and disregard the legitimate elector certificates from those seven states.

A review of the apparently fraudulent elector certificates, along with the aforementioned open source reporting and public statements made by individuals closely affiliated with the Trump Campaign, reasonably indicate the existence of a federal crime. Accordingly, the FBI seeks to open a full investigation into whether individuals conspired to obstruct justice by unlawfully impeding Congress's certification of the Electoral College vote on January 6, 2020.

Opening of this full investigation is governed by the DOJ Memo. The DOJ Memo requires written notification to and consultation with the Assistant Attorney General and U.S. Attorney with jurisdiction over the matter and written approval of the Attorney General, through the Deputy Attorney General, prior the opening of any investigation of a declared candidate for president or vice president, a presidential campaign, or a senior presidential campaign staff member or advisor. It is assessed that the pool of potential subjects may include individuals who fall into one or more of these categories. Although members of the 45th Presidential administration are no longer in office, the DOJ Memo states that the scope of this policy should be broadly construed to ensure that Department leadership is made aware of the opening of matters that could potentially be disruptive to the democratic process if publicly disclosed prior to an election, encouraging the FBI to err on the side of caution or seeking approval if there could be any question as to whether such actions are required under this policy.

The Assistant Attorney General for the Criminal Division has been consulted, as has the U.S. Attorney for the District of Columbia.

This Electronic Communication seeks approval to close the captioned full Sensitive Investigative Matter (SIM) investigation as a C-5 closing following a declination from the Department of Justice. The Domestic Investigations and Operations Guide (DIOG) Section 7.12.1 provides the standards for closing a full investigation, which are discussed herein. In accordance with DIOG Sections 7.12.2 and 7.7.1.2, because this was a SIM opened by a Field Office and involved a presidential candidate, the same level of approval required to open the investigation -- including the FBI Director and the Attorney General -- is also required to close the investigation. As attached hereto as a 1A and provided to the undersigned on May 20, 2025, FBI Acting Director Daniel J. Bongino and Attorney General Pamela Bondi approved closing the captioned investigation.

Closing Standard

- **Summary of the Results of the Investigation**

On April 13, 2022, following the signed approval of both FBI Director Christopher Wray and Attorney General Merrick Garland, the captioned FBI investigation was opened as a full sensitive investigative matter. On August 1, 2023 and August 27, 2024, Grand Juries sitting in the District of Columbia returned True Bills on an Indictment and a Superseding Indictment, respectively, charging Donald J. Trump (collectively, the "Indictments"). Based on a Department of Justice, Office of Legal Counsel opinion, the Indictments were dismissed without prejudice.

This investigation is subject to a litigation hold and is on the freeze list; as a result, no evidence can be returned or destroyed and must be retained. As required by the Field Evidence Management Policy Guide Sections 4.15 & 4.18, ASAC approval to retain all evidence notwithstanding closure was obtained (Serial 1206) and is attached hereto as a 1A for ease of review. The Retention EC specifies that the evidence will be retained until at least February 1, 2030, but in no case prior to the lift of the freeze and litigation hold and that the Special Counsel's Office concurred with the retention of evidence.

- **Summary of the Reason for Closing and Department of Justice Concurrence**

The SCO has submitted a final confidential report to the Attorney General, has concluded its work, and is winding down the office. Under the circumstances, the SCO must decline further prosecution of the FBI's Arctic Frost Investigation, and we do not object to FBI closing the case file. As stated in public filings, the SCO dismissed the case against Donald Trump based on his impending inauguration as president, consistent with the Department's longstanding policy prohibiting the indictment and prosecution of a sitting president; the dismissal was not based on the merits of the prosecution, which the SCO stands behind. I note that Mr. Trump was charged with participating in crimes with at least six co-conspirators. Before the Department concluded that the case against Mr. Trump must be dismissed, the SCO had made a preliminary determination that the admissible evidence could justify seeking charges against certain co-conspirators. The SCO had also begun to evaluate how to proceed, including whether any potential charged case should be joined with Mr. Trump's or brought separately. Because the SCO reached no final conclusions, our declination of further prosecution should not be read to exonerate any particular person.

Details:

This Electronic Communication seeks ASAC approval for the retention of all undisposed evidence in the captioned investigation and all subfiles, including following case closing pursuant to the Field Evidence Management Policy Guide Section 4.18. The case is on the freeze list and a litigation hold is in place. The anticipated disposition date is no earlier than February 1, 2030, but in no case prior to the lift of the freeze and litigation hold. The Deputy Special Counsel concurs with this request.

Summary of the Investigation

On April 13, 2022, following the signed approval of both FBI Director Christopher Wray and Attorney General Merrick Garland, the captioned FBI

investigation was opened. See Serial 1.

During the course of the investigation, various investigative techniques were used, including grand jury subpoenas, orders pursuant to Section 2703(d), recorded and unrecorded interviews, voluntary productions of documents, search warrants, and the collection of open source materials.

On August 1, 2023, a Grand Jury sitting in the District of Columbia returned a True Bill on an Indictment charging Donald J. Trump ("Trump") with violations of 18 U.S.C. § 371 (conspiracy to defraud the United States), 18 U.S.C. § 1512(k) (conspiracy to obstruct an official proceeding), 18 U.S.C. § 1512(c)(2) and 2 (obstruction of an official proceeding & attempt to obstruct an official proceeding), and 18 U.S.C. § 241 (conspiracy against rights). See *United States v. Trump*, 23-CR-257-TSC, ECF No. 1 (Aug. 1, 2023); Serial 1021. Following an immunity determination by the Supreme Court, on August 27, 2024, a grand jury returned a True Bill on a Superseding Indictment, charging Trump with the same four felony counts (collectively, the "Indictments"). See *United States v. Trump*, ECF No. 226 (Aug. 27, 2024); Serial 1196.

As a result of the November 5, 2024 election, Trump is now president-elect and will be inaugurated as president on January 20, 2025. As a result of the Department of Justice, Office of Legal Counsel's opinion that a sitting president cannot be federally indicted and prosecuted, the United States moved to dismiss the Indictments without prejudice before Trump's inauguration. See *United States v. Trump*, ECF No. 281. On November 25, 2024, the District Court granted the Government's unopposed motion and dismissed the Indictments without prejudice. See *United States v. Trump*, ECF Nos. 282 & 283. As detailed further in the attached 1A email from the Deputy Special Counsel regarding the declination of further prosecution, "the dismissal was not based on the merits of the prosecution, which the SCO stands behind." Additionally, the "declination of further prosecution should not be read to exonerate any particular person."

Evidence Retention

Title: (U) Retention of Evidence

Pursuant to the Field Evidence Management Policy Guide (Evidence PG) Section 4.15, "Cases cannot be closed until all collected 1B evidence has been properly disposed of . . . or approved for retention. If an evidence item remains undisposed, the investigative case file must remain open, unless the criteria outlined in subsection 4.18 are met."

Evidence PG Section 4.18 provides, "In order for a case to be closed with undisposed evidence, the [Case Agent] must draft a retention EC containing the justification, concurrence from the AUSA, and the anticipated disposition date for ASAC approval."

Following the dismissal of charges and declination of further prosecution by the Special Counsel's Office, the investigation is ready to be closed; nevertheless, the Special Counsel's Office concurs with the retention of evidence in this case. On January 8, 2024, the Deputy Special Counsel wrote, "Under the circumstances, and in accordance with the litigation hold requiring the preservation of materials related to the SCO's work, the SCO concurs with FBI retaining evidence in the Arctic Frost Investigation/SCO Election Interference Investigation." See attached 1A. Such retained items include, but are not limited to, search warrant material (e.g., 1B55 & 1B57), interview recordings (1D items), voluntary productions, grand jury material, open source downloads, and a compilation of all discovery provided to Trump during the prosecution of *United States v. Trump*, 23-CR-257-TSC (1B56).

Pursuant to Evidence PG Section 4.18, and notwithstanding preparing to close this investigation, the undersigned respectfully requests ASAC authorization to retain all evidence associated with this investigation until at least February 1, 2030, but in no case prior to the lift of the freeze and litigation hold.
